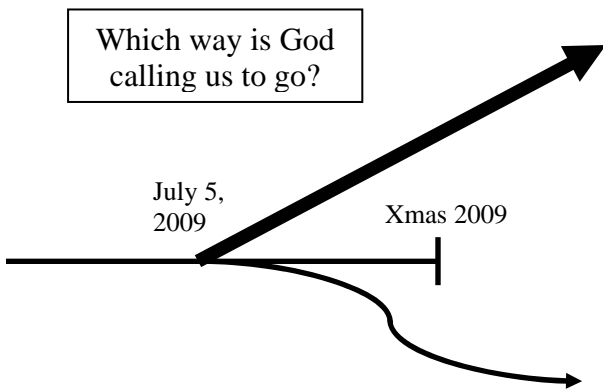


Bethlehem at the Crossroads of Mission



A) Transformation Focus most of our energy on outreach, mission, empowering leaders, serving neighbors, others, and the world. B) No Change Doing what we’ve been doing. Saying: “Let’s keep on keeping on.” This means: funding runs out by Christmas, leaders run out of steam before then.

C) Maintenance Focus most of our energy on our members, fellowship and worship, caring for one another, and preserving what we’ve got (as best we can). Asking: “What does God want us to do for each other?” This means: scaling back ministries, part time pastor, finding creative ways to share building costs.
